

POLICY ON GUESTS RESIDING ON CAMPUS FOR NON-FORMAL STUDY

This policy has been adopted to accommodate individuals who wish to live on campus for a limited time to engage in non-formal study experiences and to benefit from the APTS academic and spiritual environment.

- a. The program is available only to singles or couples; no families will be accommodated. Minimum age is 20 years. Approval of AdCom is required.
- b. Such individuals will pay daily guest rate for the time on campus for housing and any meal service requested.
- c. Housing will be in a dorm room, studio or one-bedroom apartment on a space-available basis.
- d. No more than three such individuals/couples may reside on campus at one time.
- e. The limit of any stay on campus is 12 weeks. Subsequent visits must be interrupted by a minimum of eight week period.
- f. Such guests may participate in chapel services, use library facilities and participate in other non-academic campus programs. With permission of the instructor they may audit courses, paying the appropriate audit fees. However, guests may not participate in the regular APTS English program either as enrollees or auditors. English instruction must be privately arranged and paid for.
